

PROCLAMATION

On April 3, 2003 the World Health Organization (WHO) Collaborating Centre and Safe Communities Canada officially designated Calgary as a member of the International Safe Community Network. This designation was renewed in March 2009, demonstrating a long standing commitment of this city to the safety of its citizens. *Safe Communities Day* is a celebration of community partners across Canada working together to increase awareness and understanding of the benefits of investing in proactive health and safety strategies towards preventing incidents of violence and injury at home, at work and during recreational activities.

- Whereas: The vision of Safe Communities Canada is to make Calgary the safest city in Canada to live, learn, work and play;
